AIDA Policy position on cultural safety

In 2013, AIDA released a policy position paper; *Cultural Safety for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander doctors, medical students and patients*. The paper states that cultural safety is about overcoming the cultural power imbalances of places, people and policies to contribute to improvements in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health. It also provides guidance and outlines the parameters for AIDA in our work to advocate for a health system that is culturally safe, high quality, reflective of need and respects and incorporates Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural values.
